I would like to invite you to participate on The Lincoln Public Schools Special Education Advisory Committee. School districts' are required to establish an advisory committee made up of parents, teachers, school administrators, and related service providers. The Advisory Committee members work together on behalf of students identified with disabilities and their families. The majority of the members must be parents of students who have an Individual Education Program (IEP).

Roles and responsibilities of Advisory Committees can include: advocating in partnership with parents for students with disabilities to ensure they receive what they are entitled to under state and federal law, commenting on improvement plans (including school improvement plans), commenting on the school district's compliance with State and Federal laws related to the education of students with disabilities, and commenting on applications of federal and state funds.

Many Advisory Committees across the state also try to identify parent information needs in order to provide workshops and seminars on issues confronting parents of students with special needs.
