The following are requirements regarding TB testing and MMR records:

The Lincoln Public School Department requires that a physician certifies you are free of communicable tuberculosis. This certificate must be based on a skin test and a physical examination. If your skin test is positive, you will probably need an x-ray.

NOTE TO PHYSICIAN: An x-ray may not be substituted for a Mantoux skin test.

2. **MMR.** The Lincoln Public School Department requires that all school personnel born after 1/1/57 who are in direct contact with students need to provide evidence of immunization against measles, mumps and rubella (MMR) by either:

- ❖ Documentation of immunization
- ❖ Evidence of natural immunity by serologic testing (blood titer) or physician diagnosed disease – see info on 2nd page if you need to go this route
- ❖ Medical or religious exemption
